Euclid Ave. Closure (E. 6th St. – E. 9th St.)

(City of Cleveland Ward 3)

CLEVELAND – Effective Friday morning, September 15th, at 6:00 a.m., Euclid Ave. will be closed between E. 6th St. and E. 9th St. for the removal of a tower crane at the City Club Apartments. A detour will be posted. Euclid Ave. will reopen on Monday, September 18th, at 6:00 a.m.

Traffic will be maintained between Public Square and E. 6th St. for the duration of this work. On-street parking will not be permitted between E. 6th St. and E. 9th St.
