**South Moreland, Shaker Square,
North Moreland Improvements
Traffic Advisory
(Griffing Avenue to Larchmere Boulevard)
(City of Cleveland – Wards 4 and 6)**

Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue

CLEVELAND – Beginning Wednesday, April 10, 2024, The City of Cleveland will restart construction of the South Moreland, Shaker Square, North Moreland Improvement Project, beginning in the southwest quadrant of Shaker Square.

Overall Project Description:

The project includes resurfacing of South Moreland, Shaker Square, and North Moreland from Griffing Avenue to Larchmere Boulevard. Work will include milling of existing asphalt and replacement, base repairs, utility casting adjustments, ADA compliant ramps, replacement of concrete curbs and walks as needed, pavement markings and signage. Safety improvements include realignment of intersections at Livingston, Ashwood, and Hampton Roads. A new mast-arm signal will replace the existing span wire signal at Drexmore. New pavement layout will include bike lanes, new left-turn lanes, and parking lanes as appropriate.

Construction Traffic Detours:

The upcoming construction and traffic detours will be as follows:

- At the southwest quadrant of Shaker Square as water main replacement is being performed traffic will be detoured from the intersection of Shaker Square and Shaker Boulevard east, then south on Van Aken Boulevard, and then west on Drexmore Road ending at South Moreland Boulevard.
- Patrons of the Goldenrod Montessori Preschool coming from the eastern neighborhoods on Shaker Boulevard westbound are advised to continue west, past Shaker Square, turn south onto East 121 Street and then continue eastbound on Shaker Boulevard to the school drop-off zone on Shaker Boulevard.

- Traffic detours for the southwest quadrant of Shaker Square will begin April 10, 2024 and will continue until late May 2024.
- The next phase of construction will be north of Shaker Square on North Moreland Boulevard. A traffic advisory will be issued detailing the traffic detours associated with this phase of construction.

Construction zones will be installed and advanced warning signs will be placed outside of the work area informing the public of the construction work and any changes in the traffic patterns.

The work on this project will generally take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The overall project is scheduled for completion in October 2024.
