Mayor Frank G. Jackson Scholarship Program Information

The Mayor Frank G. Jackson Scholarship Program has been established to support City of Cleveland employees, their children and Cleveland Metropolitan School District students who are interested in pursuing a full-time college education beginning fall semester, August 2011.

City of Cleveland employees and their children will be offered an opportunity to apply for one of the following scholarships:

- **Five** children of City of Cleveland employees who are graduating seniors entering into their first year of enrollment at a post-secondary institution (four-year college/university) will be awarded \$2,000.00 each.
- **Five children** of City of Cleveland employees who are currently enrolled at a four-year college will receive \$1,000.00 each.
- **Five City of Cleveland employees earning a bachelors** degree will receive \$1,000.00 each (full or part-time).
- **Twenty-one \$2,000.00** scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors from the City of Cleveland Recreation Centers.

Cleveland Metropolitan School District students will be offered an opportunity to apply for one of the following scholarships:

- **Ten Cleveland** Metropolitan School District graduating seniors entering into their first year of enrollment at a post-secondary institution (four-year college/university) will be awarded \$2,000.00 each.
- **One \$2,000.00** scholarship will be awarded to a student who will be attending a Historically Black College or University.

Applicants must apply on line at www.uncf.org. Certified transcripts and two letters of recommendation must be uploaded with the application.

The deadline for applications is Friday, April 29, 2011. All applicants will be notified of scholarship award decisions by Friday, June 3, 2011. For more information, contact Monyka S. Price, Chief of Education at 216-420-8087.
