Pursuant to Paragraph 361 of the Consent Decree, the Monitor is required to “conduct a reliable, comprehensive, and representative survey of members of the Cleveland community regarding their experiences with and perceptions of [the Cleveland Division of Police (CDP)] and of public safety” every two years, with “the results of this survey . . . included in the outcome assessments.” Dkt. 7-1 ¶ 361. The Monitoring Team previously updated the Court on the process used to secure the firm, Ideas in Focus, to conduct focus groups assessing the

perceptions of individuals in the Cleveland community with respect to the CDP. *See* Dkt. 135 at 15-17.

The Monitoring Team hereby submits Ideas in Focus's report on the results of the initial community survey, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
