The Second-Year Monitoring Plan required the Cleveland Division of Police (“CDP”) to revise an existing General Police Order (“GPO”) “to include express, minimum standard qualifications for in-service training instructors.” Dkt. 120-1 at 8. The purpose was to ensure that instructors who provide ongoing officer training have sufficient skills and real-world experience necessary to provide high-quality instruction.

The Monitoring Team has closely reviewed CDP’s revised In-Service Instructor/External Instructor Selection policy, attached hereto as Exhibit A. The revised GPO provides clear minimum standards, including that trainers have at least five years of sworn experience, be “free of sustained discipline” for two years, and have received at least a “satisfactory” annual performance review. Ex. A at 1. The selection process is detailed and straightforward. Guidelines for what selected instructors must do, as well as for external instructors, are similarly clear. Therefore, the Monitoring Team approves the GPO.
