Pursuant to the Revised Third-Year Monitoring Plan in the above-captioned matter, the City of Cleveland (the “City”) and Department of Justice (collectively, “the Parties”), as well as the Monitoring Team, have agreed to extend the deadlines for a number of milestones relating to the Cleveland Division of Police’s (“CDP” or “Division”) District Policing Committee Strategy (“DPC Strategy”). The Monitoring Team and Parties respectfully request that the Court approve the extension of the milestones.

The Parties and Monitoring Team continue to work through the development of the Division’s DPC Strategy and require additional time to finalize the strategy. The CDP will provide the Updated Draft of the DPC Strategy on August 17, 2018 to the Parties, Monitoring Team, and the Community Police Commission. Subsequent deadlines relating to the DPC Strategy under the

Revised Third-Year Monitoring Plan will be extended by the same amount of time. The below deadlines reflect the proposed new timeline for finalization and approval of the DPC Strategy, with new deadlines in red:

The Monitor recommends approval or disapproval of the Final Draft of the District Policing Committee Strategy to the Court, either in whole or in part. The determination will be based on the extent to which the plan adequately complies with the requirements of the Agreement, incorporates feedback of the Parties, and reflects the values and specific input of community and Division stakeholders.
