Villaview Road Resurfacing Project

East 162nd Street to East 200th Street (City of Cleveland - Ward 8)

CLEVELAND – The City of Cleveland is planning a project that involves the repair and resurfacing of Villaview Road from East 162nd Street to East 200th Street. In addition, the proposed project will also include pavement base repairs, concrete joint repairs, casting adjustments, ADA compliant curb ramps, new pavement markings and signage. Construction is currently scheduled to begin in the May 2025 and completed by the end of the year.

The City is obliged, by Federal regulations, to have a thirty day public comment period as federal funds will be utilized for this project. We welcome your questions and comments.

Issues you may wish to comment on may include, but are not limited to, the effect of the project on local residents, air quality, the local economy, floodplains, and historic or cultural resources. Comments are requested by June 17, 2024, to ensure your that they will be considered during project development.

A public meeting to review the design of the project will be scheduled in early Fall 2024.
